TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Pilgrims Way, Hythe will be closed to through traffic, on or after 23rd January 2023 for up to 14 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Stone Street and Staple Lane.

The alternative route is via Stone Street, Hempton Hill, Farthing Common, Loughborough Lane, Sandling Road and Staple Lane.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Highways Contractor Services Ltd.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
