As restrictions begin to be lifted, we will continue to adapt what is happening in the church and the village, so that more events can take place face to face.

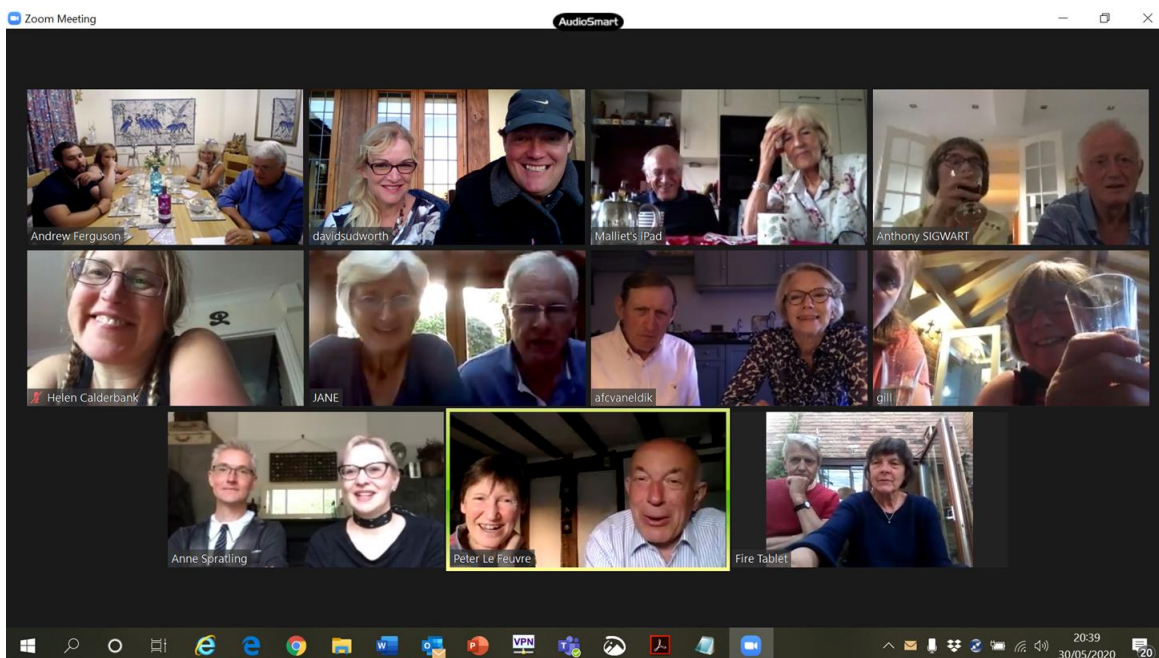
Let's hope that the Coffee Mornings and the Craft Days can be back soon.
