Minutes of Postling Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday 26 September 2018, at 6.30pm in Postling Village Hall.

- 1. Present: Cllr Frank Hobbs in the chair, Cllrs Christine Hobbs, John Pattrick, John Elphick, Helen Calderbank, Charlie Wilkins, District Councillor Jenny Hollingsbee and County Councillor Susan Carey.
- 2. Declarations of interest: As former owners of the land concerned, Cllrs Frank Hobbs and Christine Hobbs declared an interest in item 5a.
- 3. Minutes: **It was resolved** to accept the minutes of meeting held on 25 July 2018 and Extraordinary Meeting held on 29 August 2018 which were signed by the Chairman.
- 4. Matters arising from previous meeting: Appointment of new Clerk confirmed; Kingston plot nothing to report.
- 5. Planning Applications:
  - a. Y18/0913/FH Stour Rise, Staple Lane, Postling
     Change of use of the land for the keeping of horses and erection of a stable building.
     It was resolved to make no objection to this application on condition land and stable is for personal use only and not for commercial livery.
  - b. Y18/1145/FH Churchfield, Pilgrims Way, Postling Erection of a single storey rear garden room.
     It was resolved to support this application.
- 6. Finance:

- d. Budget to be prepared for approval at November meeting.
- 7. It was resolved to approve Standing Orders and Financial Regulations.
- 8. A20 Closure: Recent phase of works has been completed. Beachborough will be closed from 1 Oct for 2 weeks.
- 9. Reports:
  - a. District Councillor Jenny Hollingsbee reported the Princes Parade development went to committee and was passed. An objection from Southern Water is to be resolved. The joint District meeting was postponed, the next one will be in November. 'Spotlight', an online database of voluntary organisations and charitable organisations in F&HD, will be launched in October (a link will be added to the Postling website).
  - b. County Councillor Susan Carey reported she had recently visited Lyminge with Damian Collins MP to discuss the frustrating lack of progress with a Post Office service. Mr Collins has since been in touch with the P.O. who say they will look into provision. Last week, 70 potholes were filled and 1,243 sq m of road surface patched. Reserves have
